

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-O-05**  
**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION**  
**OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF HARTFORD**

**WHEREAS**, Article 7, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois encourages intergovernmental cooperation and authorizes units of local government to contract and associate amongst themselves to obtain or share services and to exercise, combine or transfer any power or function in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance; and


Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage.
